



Procedure for Cebu Arrivals

Due to the evolving COVID-19 situation, PAL and the Philippine Government have issued precautionary measures, mandatory protocols and requirements for travelers. For passengers in international flights to the Philippines, please be guided on new arrival and quarantine procedures in Manila, Cebu, and Clark.

We encourage all passengers to follow the guide, register in advance and pre-book their hotels as necessary to avoid any inconvenience and experience faster processing upon arrival. You will find all details step by step with below images.

Note: Families traveling together with at least one OFW will be considered all OFWs. Non-OFWs refer to Returning Overseas Filipinos (except OFWs), spouse and children of Filipinos, diplomats, foreign officials accredited by the Philippines, and eligible non-Filipino/foreign citizens with long-term visas.

ARRIVING IN CEBU



BEFORE YOU FLY

Register not earlier than five (5) days prior to departure via the online MCI A Passenger Arrival Registration Form. Take note of your Travel Registration Number (TRN).

For Land-Based OFWs

Complete the OFW Assistance Information System

For Returning Overseas Filipinos

Make a booking at a hotel accredited by the Philippine Tourism and Health Authorities



AFTER CHECK-IN

Present the following to the check-in agent:

- Valid Passport
- Valid visa with proof of filiation or marriage, if applicable
- For Returning Overseas Filipinos or foreign nationals,** proof of pre-booked Cebu hotel accommodation
- Travel Reference Number
- Health Declaration Form (HDF) available upon check-in

UPON ARRIVAL

- 1** Present your TRN at the Validation Counter and claim your barcode for identification and swab testing
- 2** Undergo thermal scanning and submit the Health Declaration Form
- 3** Proceed to Immigration and submit the Arrival Card

AT THE ARRIVAL HALL

For Land-Based OFWs

Proceed to the OWWA desk for your assigned hotel

For Sea-Based OFWs

Proceed to the MARINA desk for your assigned hotel

For Returning Overseas Filipinos

Proceed to the cashier and pay for your COVID-19 RT-PCR Test

ARRIVING IN CEBU



AT THE ARRIVAL HALL

- 1 Undergo briefing by the assigned agency and proceed to the waiting area
- 2 Submit the barcode to the health personnel
- 3 Undergo COVID-19 RT-PCR Test

EXITING THE TERMINAL

1 Retrieve your baggage at the assigned carousel

2 Go through Customs Check and let your respective agencies/hotel representatives assist you to your designated shuttle for transfer to your assigned hotel

AT THE HOTEL

- 1** Check-in and wait for your test results, which may take up to 2 days

Test results will be sent via the e-mail address you provided during registration

- 2** **NEGATIVE RESULT**
Present your result to the assigned quarantine personnel at the hotel for clearance

POSITIVE RESULT
You will be endorsed by the BOQ to a hospital for further medical management

- 3** If you require a BOQ medical certificate, you may obtain your certificate via the DOH-BOQ certificate page.



RETURNING HOME

(for passengers terminating in Cebu)

or arrange your own transportation going home
